The minutes and financial statement from September 22, 2008, were read. Marilyn Lorenzen made the approval motion, seconded by Colleen Bicandi, the motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS:

President Cammi Veenstra allowed School Superintendent Sue Beitia to present items of business to the organization because she had other commitments and needed to leave. The first item of business was Sue stated she wanted to be an EHS Alumni Association member, and handed a check for dues to Secretary/Treasurer Connie Goins.

The second item of business presented by Sue was information about the May 19, 2009, school levy bond. She stated the school board trustees have taken leadership and presented a \$3.4 million school levy bond to the residents of Gem County. After explaining the cash flow and the bullet points of the flyer, she asked the group for their support of the school levy bond by placing the EHS Alumni Association name on the backside of the flyer along with other supporters. Glenda Kirkpatrick made a motion to add our organization's name to the flier in support of the school levy bond. Seconded by Marilyn Lorenzen, the motion passed.

The third item of business that Sue presented was to get the community involved with signage – "Home of the Huskies". She stated other communities showed school support by signage and she wanted to know if the EHS Alumni Association would be interested in purchasing a banner used to display Huskie spirit. Discussion followed, and it was determined that our by-laws did not allow this type of purchase. Glenn Morrow made a motion to deny purchasing a banner, seconded by Arleen Becken, the motion passed.

The group discussed having a table at different community events (Harvest Festival, Cherry Festival, Gem County Fair) to get people aware of our organization.

Our main goal of the April meeting is to select scholarship recipients. Based upon Glenn Morrow's motion at the September 22, 2008, meeting to choose three (3) recipients plus one more that had been vacated by Alex Beers, the group proceeded to choose four (4) recipients. Each recipient will receive a \$500.00 scholarship.

Secretary/Treasurer Connie Goins presented a scoring sheet that she had developed. The association reviewed the nineteen (19) scholarship applications received from Chris Holbrook of the EHS counselor's office. After careful reviewing, the group selected the following four recipients:
